H.Res.919 - Department of Reconciliation

- This resolution, introduced on February 9th, 2022 declares an unconditional war on invidious discrimination and would resolve to establish a cabinet level Department of Reconciliation to wage this war.
 - The Department would oversee the development and implementation of a comprehensive national strategy to eliminate racism and invidious discrimination.
 - The Department would have a budget equivalent to not less than **10%** of the Defense Department's budget to ensure the Department's important work could not be stopped by defunding.
 - This resolution aims to not only relieve the symptoms of racism and invidious discrimination, but to cure and, above all, prevent them.
 - The resolution was created in the spirit of President Johnson's declaration of unconditional war on poverty.
 - The text of the resolution condemns racism and invidious discrimination as evil and antithetical to the U.S. Constitution, declaring unconditional war on racism and invidious discrimination in America and calling for resources and funding necessary for their defeat.
- H.Res.919 Department of Reconciliation:
 - Has 34 cosponsors
 - Is waiting to be brought to the House floor.
